



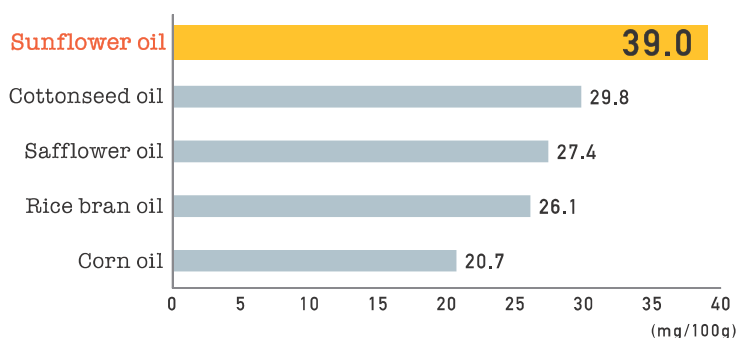

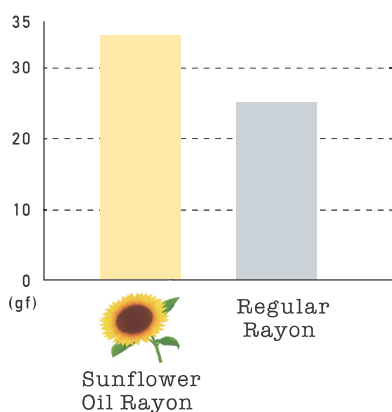
Contents of vitamin E in botanical oils



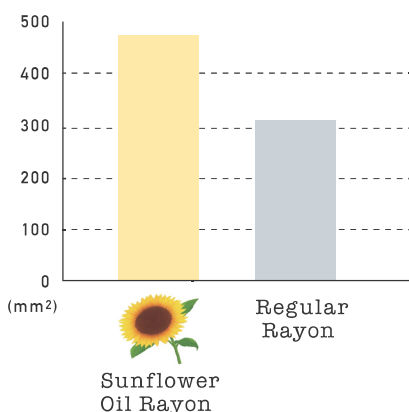
## Smoother and skin-friendly

Sunflower Oil Rayon has about 1.5 times liquid absorbency and adhesion properties compared to those of regular rayon, resulting in a more efficient penetration of the drug solution into the skin. In addition, sunflower oil—which is rich in oleic acid, a major component of human sebum—offers a softer feeling than regular rayon. The moist texture is gentle on dry skin.

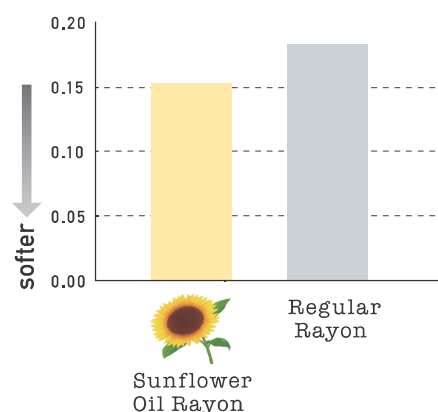
Adhesion properties

<Testing method>

Adhesion properties: KES compression test (a pull-up force [gf] is measured when a compression load of 50 g/m<sup>2</sup> is applied to a sample impregnated with the drug solution)

Liquid absorbency: Spot testing method

Softness: KES method; smaller values indicate softer textures
